# Masjid Entrance

Separate entries for men and women.

For women, **entrance** into the masjid will be **from the front doors until full**.

Sister's side doors will be locked, entry will only be permitted for elderly and pregnant women.

Depending on traffic, volunteers may close certain doors.



# Safety

## Ramadan Volunteers

- Please respect and follow their directives
- Guiding traffic
- Identifiable with vests

## Shoes

- Place on shoe shelves
- Do not create a hazard



# Safety

## Chairs

- Strategically placed away from emergency exits, please do not move them

## Children

- Must remain with parents **at all times**
- Volunteers & security are not responsible
- Children **cannot** be left unattended in Mommy/Daddy & Me rooms

## Strollers

- Place in designated areas only



# Prayer

It is **not permitted** to hold a spot for someone in the musallah.

Once all areas are full, the rotunda doors **will be locked**. Prayer can be completed in the overflow areas.

After prayer, women leave through the side doors.

People (both men and women) not praying will not be allowed in Musallah during Salah time. This is to allow the maximum number of people praying into the hall.



# DRESS CODE FOR INSIDE A MASJID

While there's no strict dress code, masjids are places of worship. To show respect, we recommend modest clothing for both men and women. Wearing loose clothing that covers your arms and legs is encouraged.

- No transparent clothing
- No clothing with profanity or haram images
  - No shorts or short skirts
  - No Sleeveless Shirts
- Head covering while inside the Prayer Hall

## VRIC Ramadan Policies & Guidelines

To ensure a peaceful and organized experience for all worshippers, we kindly ask everyone to adhere to the following policies during Ramadan:

### General Masjid Etiquette

- No Food or Drinks in the Musallah – To maintain cleanliness and respect for the prayer space, no food or drinks are allowed inside the musallah. ONLY water is allowed in closed bottles.
- Dress Code – Please wear modest, Islamic attire that is appropriate for the masjid.
- Respect the Prayer Space – If you are not praying, kindly leave the musallah to allow space for those who need to pray.
- Use the Shoe Racks – Please place your shoes on the designated shoe racks and avoid leaving them on the floor or in walkways.

### Seating & Space Management

- Backrest Prayer Mats – Only permitted in front of the bookcases during the Heart Softeners lectures to maintain space for all attendees.
- No Spot Saving – Please do not reserve spots for others. Spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Children Supervision – Parents must supervise their children at all times!

### Safety & Security

- Follow Volunteer & Security Instructions – Volunteers and security personnel are there to ensure a smooth experience for everyone. Failure to comply may result in removal from the premises.
- No Blocking Entrances & Exits – Do not sit, stand, or leave belongings in doorways, walkways, or emergency exit areas.
- Parking Lot Courtesy – Park only in designated areas, avoid double-parking, and follow traffic guidelines to ensure safety.

### Community Spirit

- Keep the Masjid Clean – Dispose of trash properly and return Qur'ans and books to their proper places after use.
- Phones on Silent – Ensure your phone is on silent or vibrate mode to avoid disturbing prayers and lectures.
